PLEASE NOTE, THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT!

IT IS A CONDITION OF OUR PLANNING PERMISSION AND LICENCE THAT ALL GUESTS ARE OFF THE PREMISES BY 10.30. PLEASE THEREFORE BOOK YOUR TAXI FROM LES LAVEURS IN GOOD TIME. IF THERE IS ANYONE HERE AT 10.30, WE RUN THE RISK OF LOOSING OUR LICENCE SO WILL HAVE TO CLOSE DOWN. PLEASE RESPECT OUR WISHES!

Also, we have no parking! We would encourage you to walk, cycle, get a lift or a taxi to the barn but,

if you have to bring your car, parking is at Les Laveurs Car Park (opposite Jersey Pearl).

We understand that this car park has a 12 in 24 hour parking limit so would advise you to make sure it is not left overnight.

Please tell us what time you will be there and we will arrange for a driver to meet you and bring you to La Cidrerie. We will also arrange for the taxi to return you to your vehicle at the end of your evening. This service is free of charge to our guests.

If you are booking a taxi to take you home, please ask them to meet you at Les Laveurs Car Park

DO NOT PARK IN THE VICINITY OF THE RESTAURANT, ON MONT DES CORVEES OR LA ROUTE DE TRODEZI!

My apologies for the above but we have two neighbours who are particularly sensitive to traffic, parked cars and NOISE. We need to ensure that all our neighbours are in no way inconvenienced by our business so please do respect our request!

If you are walking, cycling or getting a lift, these are the directions to La Cidrerie.

Turn into La Rue des Bonne Femmes from Le Mont des Corvees.

La Rue des Bonne Femmes bends round to the left, then round to the right. La Robeline Farm is located on the right hand side of the right hand bend and has black gates leading into their courtyard - **that is not us!!!**

DO NOT follow the road round to the right into La Rue de La Robeline. Instead, the lane which leads to our house is on the left, on this bend - it used to be called La Verte Rue and is a tarmacked narrow lane. There is a blue sign saying "Caution Road Narrows" and two wheelie bins on the left hand side - please get dropped off at the top of the lane and walk down. We are at the bottom.

- Bicycles can be parked next to the "Old Barn" on the concrete area next to the high double doors.
- If you get a lift or a taxi to us, please ask the driver to drop you at the top of the lane and walk down.
- **Please arrange for your lift or taxi at the end of the evening to collect you from Les Laveurs carpark (Opposite Jersey Pearl) and let me know what time it is booked for. We will have a driver on hand to take you to the carpark.**

Two of our neighbours (either side of the lane) have a problem with noise so, if you are walking or cycling, please try not to shout when arriving at or leaving La Cidrerie!
