<b>Kent &amp; W. Sussex England</b>	<b>Gusbourne Brut Reserve, 2019</b> Gusbourne's best selling wine. Gusbourne only make vintage wines (no NV or blends) and this 2019 Brut Reserve succeeds in aiming for a wine that is 'approachable', well balanced and delicious. The Chardonnay is the backbone, the Pinot Noir brings body and depth and the Pinot Meunier adds floral and additional fruity notes. ABV 12%	75cl Bottle	£88.00
<b>Cornwall England</b>	<b>Camel Valley, Pinot Noir Brut Rosé NV</b> Camel Valley (in Cornwall) is the only English winery so far to be granted the Royal Warrant (Prince of Wales). This 'Royal favourite' pink fizz is made from 100% Pinot Noir. Characteristic aromas of wild strawberries and raspberries, very well balanced with a pure, refreshing finish. <b>Champagne, France</b>	<b>Champagne, "Forget-Brimont", Brut, Premier Cru</b> Pale golden colour. Delicate nose, very fresh, lovely complexity. Fresh and supple on the palate. <b>Champagne, France</b>	<b>Champagne, "Forget-Brimont", Premier Cru, Rosé</b> This Rosé Champagne is a blend of 60% Pinot Noir 20% Pinot Meunier and 20% Chardonnay. The rosé colour comes from adding red Champagne wine to the reserve cuvée and through the delicate blending, an intense and fruity bouquet is evident with ample mouth feel and great finish. <b>Burgundy, France</b>	<b>Henri Champliau Crémant de Bourgogne</b> From Mercurey in the Côte Chalonnaise in Burgundy, this wonderful soft crémant is made from a blend of 82% Pinot Noir and 18% Chardonnay. Refined with elegant bubbles, delicate notes of red berries on the nose, clear and fruity on the palate, with finesse, length and freshness. Perfect apéritif and great with seafood. <b>Northern Italy</b>	<b>Pinot Grigio "La Jara", 2022 (Organic)</b> La Jara, just north of Venice has won many awards for their wines including this one. Pinot Grigio doesn't always have the best reputation but this is nothing like your average Pinot Grigio: it's dry, light, elegant, full of fresh summer fruits like peaches & apricots and slightly floral – delicious. Trentino <b>Italy</b>	<b>“Terrazze Della Luna”, Trentino Pinot Grigio DOC.</b> The name refers to 'terraces of the moon' - the selected hillside vineyards of Trentino where grapes for this distinctive Pinot Grigio are sourced. A zesty wine with excellent concentration and depth. The grapes are sourced from the best hillside vineyard sites of Valle dell'Adige (where the soils are ventilated and well drained). Stone fruit, apple and floral nose. The palate shows delicate yet complex floral notes, subtle mineral character and attractive white fruit leading to fresh citrus acidity on the finish. Pays Nantais, Loire Valley, <b>France</b>	<b>Muscadet de Sevre et Maine Sur Lie, Château de la Cassemichere.</b> By sight, the wine looks pale yellow in colour with green highlights. It has aromas of fresh and dried fruit. Rich and aromatic on the palate, with a great structure offering a mineral finish. One of the Cider Maker and my favourites with oysters or shell fish! Languedoc-Roussillon region <b>France</b>	<b>Picpoul de Pinet, Terre d'Eole 2023.</b> A very fresh and zingy wine from the south of France that is perfect for any summer day and pairs perfectly with seafood. Brilliant yellow robe with green tints. Flower nose with notes of hawthorn, acacia, but also citrus fruit. Round and mineral wine in the mouth with a grapefruit finish. Bourgogne, <b>France</b>	<b>Mâcon-Fuissé Domaine de Fussiacus, 2023</b> Many 'lesser' winemakers in the Macon region produce 'average' wines - the Paquet family know exactly what they were doing however. Organic farming, no added yeasts, hand harvesting & steel tanks all combine to make this really clean, fresh, unoaked chardonnay. ABV 13.5%	75cl Bottle	£36.00
Bourgogne, <b>France</b>	<b>Mâcon-Lugny, “Les Genievres” Louis Latour (Chardonnay), 2022/23.</b> Macon-Lugny 'Les Genievres' carries aromas of honey and acacia, with exceptional roundness in the mouth. Ample and complete, this wine offers flavours of white fruits and honey. The village of Lugny is located high up in the South of the Macon region. It has a great reputation for its white wines which has made Macon famous. It is well known that the village of Lugny, with its limestone soils and warm climate, produces the most coveted white wines of the region. The vineyard of 'Les Genievres' is one of the best. Maison Louis Latour selects the best grapes of this village, which, thanks to its terroir, was the only village planted with Chardonnay grapes 30 years ago. Hand-harvested grapes from hillside vineyards – precision winemaking from true experts resulting in a floral, citrus, style of Chablis – perfect with seafood. No oak at all. Bourgogne, <b>France</b>	<b>Vincent Girardin Rully 1er Cru, “Gresigny”, 2018.</b> Vibrant golden-yellow colour, juicy and fresh notes of spicy orchard fruit with a touch of minerality. The ageing in barrels gives discreet vanilla notes. Very full, rich in the mouth, full of sap and vigour ~ beautifully balanced. ABV 13%. <b>Low stock</b>	75 cl Bottle	£61.50

	<b>White Wines:</b>		
Bourgogne, <b>France</b>	<b>Domaine Faiveley Mercurey Clos Rochette, 2022.</b> Faiveley has a superb estate on the Côte Chalonnaise, and a separate, newly renovated winery in Mercurey to handle all the fruit as near to the vineyards as possible. The family is the sole proprietor of this vineyard, which vinified two-thirds in stainless steel tanks, with the balance in oak barrels. The result is a Chardonnay that has precise, pure lemon fruit character allied with delicate spice and silky texture. Pale, green-lemon colour, this has lively aromas, palate being medium bodied, poised and charmingly concentrated. This is a vibrant, finely balanced wine. ABV 13%	75cl Bottle	£69.50
Bourgogne, <b>France</b>	<b>Domaine Barraud Pouilly Fuissé Les Crays, 1er Cru 2022</b> Right next to the Roche de Vergisson the vineyard benefits from a lot of sunshine and chalky mineral soil. A suave delicate burgundy made with enormous care from the charming Barraud family without the use of pesticides or herbicides or filtration. Exemplary. ABV 13%	75cl Bottle	£78.50
Bourgogne, <b>France</b>	<b>Meursault Joseph Faiveley, 2020</b> Recognised as one of the finest producers in Burgundy, they make classic, elegant Burgundies. With exceptional terroirs for making fine Chardonnay, Meursault borders the iconic Puligny-Montrachet and the result is rich wine with vibrant acidity, harmonious balance and a lovely long palate. Marlborough <b>New Zealand</b>	<b>Waipara Sauvignon Blanc</b> A vibrant Sauvignon Blanc with lifted flavours, a generous mouth feel and texture. <b>South Africa</b>	<b>Boland Cellar Reserve Chenin Blanc Sur Lie, 2021</b> This wine shows exceptional Chenin Blanc expression and elegance in a ripe and complex style. The seamless harmony of ripe melons and stone fruit with hints of tropical flavours blend together with creamy ripe textures, creating a wine of distinction and elegance. Rheinhessen, <b>Germany</b>	<b>Riesling, Peth Wetz Estate, 2022/23</b> Peth Wetz Estate Riesling Rheinhessen is a crisp and refreshing white wine that is crafted in the renowned wine region of Rheinhessen in Germany. The estate-grown Riesling grapes are handpicked and carefully selected to produce a wine that boasts an aromatic bouquet of fruity and floral notes with a hint of minerality. On the palate, Peth Wetz Estate Riesling Rheinhessen is zesty and zippy with a bright acidity that balances the sweetness of the fruit flavors. Deliciously refreshing, with flavours of apple, peach and tropical fruit and lovely minerality. The wine shows upfront aromas of pineapple, citrus, apricots, a touch of honey and subtle floral notes. The palate is lush with the perfect balance between sweetness and fresh acidity. Barsac, <b>France</b>	<p><b>Chateau Coutet Barsac 1er Grand Cru Classé, 2017</b></p> <p>Aromatic complexity on the nose dominated by citrus and complemented by floral notes. Veneto <b>Italy</b>	<p><b>Pinot Grigio Rosé, Ponte</b></p> <p>This wine has a light pink nuance with copper reflections. Fruity, delicate, complex on the nose. Light with intense aromas of rose and red apple. It is an ideal aperitif but also matches well with slightly spicy foods. ABV 12%</p>	75cl Bottle 175ml Glass	£18.50 £6.50
Provence, <b>France</b>	<p><b>Château Pas de Cerf “Diane” Rosé, 2022</b></p> <p>Named after one of the 3 winemaker sisters at Chateau Pas du Cerf, Diane is a lovely, light Provence rosé made from a blend of Cinsault (30%), a local grape called Tibouren (30%), Grenache (30%) and Mourvedre (10%). Provence, <b>France</b>	<p><b>Château de la Gaudie “Garance” 2022</b></p> <p>From typical Provence red grapes (60% Grenache, 10% Cinsault &amp; 30% Syrah) comes this wonderful, elegant rosé. A discreet nose of small red fruits such as strawberries &amp; raspberries is followed through on the palate giving a soft, smooth finish. Perfect aperitif and accompaniment to Mediterranean dishes. Provence, <b>France</b>	<p><b>Château La Coste Lady A</b></p> <p>A beautiful and elegant wine made from a blend of Grenache, Syrah, and Cinsault grapes. Lady A offers a perfect balance of fresh acidity and fruity flavours. It has a soft pink colour, strawberry, white peach, and citrus aromas. On the palate, the flavours are vibrant and crisp with tangy notes of red fruits, melon and lemon zest. Perfect for pairing with seafood, salads, and light meat dishes. ABV 12%</p>	75cl Bottle	£37.00

Rhone, <b>France</b>	<p><b>Cotes du Rhone, “La Chapelle de Marin”</b>            With attractive, juicy, bramble fruit and floral aromas, the palate is up-front and fresh with warm spice and real depth. This is a classic southern Rhone red; ripe and characterful with smooth supple tannins. Lovely with grilled meats and Mediterranean style food. This is the Cider Maker’s “go to, quaffing wine”! Bordeaux, <b>France</b>	<p><b>Château Lascaux “Caillebosse” 2019</b>            A great value Bordeaux from Fronsac (west of St Emilion) made from 90% Merlot &amp; 10% Cabernet Sauvignon. Soft, medium bodied, plummy, fine tannins and red fruits. ABV 13.5%</p>	75cl Bottle 175ml Glass	£28.50 £9.50
<b>France</b>	<p><b>Pinot Noir “Domaine de Valmoissine”, Louis La Tour</b>            A fruity wine which offers a soft and silky palate with soft tannins. Domaine de Valmoissine is located on the site of the ancient monastery of Valmoissine at 500 meters above sea-level. This guarantees sunshine during the summer months whilst remaining cool at night and limits the possibility of spring frosts. The vineyard’s southern exposure gives the grapes perfect maturity at the same time as the Grands Crus of Corton. The yield is small in order to ensure perfect maturity and concentration of the grapes, the factors that create the best quality wines. This results in an elegant wine with remarkable finesse. Bordeaux, <b>France</b>	<p><b>Château Puyfromage, “Albert Signature”, Francs Cotes de Bordeaux</b>            The red and black fruits are very present with notes of wood and vanilla due to ageing more or less long in barrels. ABV 13.5%</p>	75cl Bottle	£33.50
Lussac, Bordeaux <b>France</b>	<p><b>Château Lucas St Emilion, 2017</b>            Château Lucas of Lussac-Saint-Emilion comprises equal parts Merlot and Cabernet Franc. 20% of this wine is aged for 12-18 months in oak barrels before blending with wine aged in stainless steel and concrete vats. Deep ruby red in hue, the nose is perfumed with those similar dark fruit characteristics. A balance of earthy spices, tobacco and blackcurrants in the mouth. Lussac is an up and coming satellite appellation of the renowned Saint Emilion region on the Right Bank of Bordeaux. There is no doubt that one of Lussac’s most prized properties is Château Lucas, owned by the Vauthier family of Château Ausone fame. From just 18 hectares of vines, three cuvée are produced. The top wine, aptly called Château Lucas, is produced from a 12-hectare vineyard. While so much of the Right Bank focuses on Merlot, the high percentage of Cabernet Franc brings a polished lift to the cuvée, vintage in and vintage out. Pairs well with red meat. Rhone, <b>France</b>	<p><b>Dom. de la Janasse Cotes du Rhone “Terre d’Argile”, 2022</b>            Fine, rich, Cotes du Rhone Villages, the Terre d’Argile is literally a stone’s throw from their Châteauneuf-du-Pape vineyards; 25% Grenache, 25% Syrah, 25% Mourvèdre &amp; 25% Carignan, complex flavour of blackcurrant and tapenade, a full-bodied style resembling it’s high profile neighbour. Bordeaux, Pomerol <b>France</b>	<p><b>Château Grand Corbin Despagne, St Emilion Grand Cru, 2019</b></p>	75cl Bottle	£68.00
Burgundy, <b>France</b>	<p><b>Domaine Tollot-Beaut Chorey-Les-Beaune “Piece du Chapitre” Monopole, 2021</b>            A light and supple Pinot Noir from arguably the best producer in the smallest appellation in Beaune – Chorey-Les-Beaune. Full of character, the nose is dominated by small dark fruits (blackberry, blueberry, cherry) with light notes of liquorice. It is well-built with elegant tannins and a well-rounded structure that gives a nice long palate. ABV 13%</p>	75cl Bottle	£68.00

Bordeaux, <b>France</b>	<b>Chateau Grand Mayne St Emilion Grand Cru Classé, 2019</b> An intense crimson colour with purple reflections. Quite discreet on the nose but good depth with notes of fresh red fruit, crushed raspberry, prolonged by liquorice and violet. On the palate, the wine is precise and taut with a tight tannic structure and balanced by a remarkable freshness. It reflects the aromatic palette found on the nose combining indulgence and energy with very persistent retro-olfaction giving length to the developing wine.	75cl Bottle	£81.50

Rioja, <b>Spain</b>	<b>Paco Garcia Crianza, 2019</b> Relatively new winery (2001) in Rioja introducing a new younger style of wine. This 2019 crianza is made from 90% Tempranillo and 10% Garnacha. After 12 months in oak, this is a nicely balanced form ~ a good vintage. NB. The hand is that of founder Paco Garcia, the winemaker's father. ABV 13.5%	75cl Bottle	£32.00
Rioja, <b>Spain</b>	<b>Urbina Selección 2000</b> Made from a selection of the very best Tempranillo grapes of the family-run Urbina Single Estate from vines more than 20 years old, it has had 28 days maceration followed by 15 months ageing in new American oak barrels. Intense, dark ruby, very concentrated berry/vanilla nose and flavours, full-bodied, well-structured with the fine elegance of the Urbina marque. ABV 13.5%	75cl Bottle	£34.50
Ribera del Duero <b>Spain</b>	<b>Bodegas Valduero Una Cepa, 2018</b> Ripe fruit on the nose, cherries, wild berries, roast aromas, vanilla & leather. Compact structure, firm tannic backbone, slightly vegetal but balanced with good acidity and fine creamy texture and good expression of fruit. A modern style of Ribero - elegant, smooth, already accessible, delicious! ABV 14%	75cl Bottle	£62.50

Piedmont, <b>Italy</b>	<b>Barbera D'Asti, Luca Bosio (2022)</b> Good, honest, value for money wine is the trademark of Luca Bosio Family Estates. This Barbera d'Asti is a lovely example - bright cherry and plum balances nicely with bright acidity and ripe soft tannins. Unoaked and unpretentious. ABV 13.5%	75cl Bottle	£32.50
