Veneto Italy	Valpolicella Classico Superiore DOC Rafael, 2022 From a family vineyard perfectly situated on the most prestigious hill of the region to the east of Lake Garda. A blend of Corvina Veronese 60%, Rondinella 25% and Molinara 15%, it is intense ruby red with dried spice perfumes and hints of leather and cherry. Well balanced and pleasantly tannic, it will go very well with white and red meats as well as most cheeses. ABV 12.5%	Bottle	£40.00

Beaujolais France	Domaine de Colette, Jacky Gauthier Beaujolais Villages 'Tradition', 2022/23 The grapes undergo carbonic maceration followed by a gentle pressing. A pleasant ruby-red colour, the wine presents fresh red fruit flavours in its youth, but over time evolve into delightful complexity. ABV 12.5%	Bottle	£46.50
Stellbosch South Africa	Rustenburg, John X Merriman (Bordeaux Blend), 2021 Expresses cassis, black currant and dark fruits complemented with cigar tobacco and sour cherry notes. As the wine ages and its fine-grained tannins soften a softer more savoury palate develops revealing wonderful drinkability and tertiary complexity. ABV 14.0%	Bottle	£50.00
Central Otago New Zealand	Mt. Difficulty, Pinot Noir 'Roaring Meg', 2022 Exhibits a lovely mix of red and black berry fruits with further complexity gained from oak spice. The wine has a sweet berry palate which displays these same characters in abundance. ABV 14.0%	Bottle	£55.00
Bordeaux France	Chateau Macquin, Saint Georges Saint-Emilion, 2022 Intense aromas of ripe raspberry and blackcurrant are coupled with spicy notes of cinnamon and pepper, complemented by lifted acidity and a lingering finish. Piedmont Italy	Cascina Radice, Barolo DOCG 'Poiana' 2018/19 100% Nebbiolo. The colour is shiny red with garnet reflections. The fragrance is complex, elegant and persistent. The taste is dry, rich and with a long aftertaste. It has good weight of flavour with ripe cherries and raspberry notes on the palate and a touch of smokiness. ABV 14.5%	Bottle	£60.00
Castilla y Leon Spain	Bodegas Valduero, Finca Azaya, 2019 Sourced from 900 metres high vineyards located on the border of Ribera del Duero and aged for 15 months in oak barrels. Aromas of fresh blueberry with hints of mint and coffee. Full-bodied with great concentration of ripe fruits on the palate well-balanced with soft tannins and a refreshing acidity. Mâconnais France	Bret Brothers, Pouilly-Fuissé 1er Cru "Au Vignerai", 2022 Established as a Premier Cru since 2020, this plot is ideally orientated on the south facing slopes of the Roche de Solutré at 350m altitude. This wine has a very Pouilly-Fuissé style with great salinity and crystallised fruits. ABV 13.5%	Bottle	£90.00
Mercurey France	Ch. de Chamirey Mercurey Blanc 1er Cru "La Mission" Monopole, 2022 Made from 100% Chardonnay, this wine reveals elegant floral aromas and notes of white fruits, enhanced by subtle spicy undertones. On the palate, it showcases vibrant freshness, remarkable minerality and a long, harmonious finish.	Bottle	£95.00

Bourgogne France	Vincent Girardin, Puligny-Montrachet Village Vieilles Vignes, 2022 Domaine Vincent Girardin Puligny-Montrachet les Vieilles Vignes is a French white wine that will leave you feeling delighted with its freshness and crispness. From the famous Burgundian region of France this wine is primarily made from Chardonnay grapes that are handpicked from old vines, hence the name “Les Vieilles Vignes”. The wine’s aroma is floral with notes of citrus and apple and on the palate it bursts with a rich, creamy texture complemented by a balanced acidity and a subtle minerality. This wine is perfect for special occasions, pairing well with seafood, shellfish and poultry dishes but also enjoyable on its own. ABV 13%	Bottle	£195.00
South Africa	Kershaw Elgin Clonal Selection Chardonnay, 2021 <i>(OK, so not from Burgundy but is is a Chardonnay and the barrels are from Burgundy!)</i> Restrained, mineral style focused on elegance with a white fruit character, some oatmeal and some complexity gained from pericarp applied wood. ABV 13.5% Angela Lloyd of Platter’s Wine Guide, SA gave it 5 stars and 95 points and in 2022 wrote of this wine:- “Sophisticated, finely crafted & already showing easy harmony. Lemony flavours, subtle though deep, enlivened by complementary acid; comfortable weight; finish clean & long.”	Bottle	£85.00

Bordeaux France	Chateau Grand Corbin-Despaigne Grand Cru Classe, Saint-Emilion, 2019 Lovely medium intensity purple on the colour, this is concentrated with clear and strong cassis and bilberry flavours and some fresh mint notes through the palate. Plenty of layers. 75% Merlot / 24% Cabernet Sauvignon / 1% Cabernet Franc. ABV 15.0%	Bottle	£75.00
Bordeaux France	Le Petit Haut Lafitte Rouge 2nd Wine of Ch. Smith Haut Lafitte, Pessac-Leognan, 2021 Aromas of cassis, plums, pipe tobacco and loamy soil. Medium-bodied, lively and elegant wine that's refined and charming. As usual, 60% Cabernet Sauvignon / 40% Merlot. ABV 13.5%	Bottle	£75.00
Bordeaux France	Chateau Angludet, Margaux, 2021 The vineyard is planted with 46% Cabernet Sauvignon, 41% Merlot and 13% Petit Verdot. The relatively large proportion of Petit Verdot demands hard work but imparts depth and richness to the wine. ABV 12.5%	Bottle	£75.00
Bordeaux France	Chateau Poujeaux, 5^{eme} Grand Cru Classe Haut-Medoc, 2022 Poujeaux wines are typically deeply coloured, wonderfully perfumed on the nose and display a seductive, creamy texture with densely concentrated cassis fruits on the palate. 55% Cabernet Sauvignon / 42% Merlot / 3% Petit Verdot. ABV 14.0%	Bottle	£80.00

Bordeaux France	La Dame De Montrose 2nd Wine of Chateau Montrose, Saint-Estephe, 2019 Dark fruit with a savoury, mineral edge on the nose, the palate lively and lifted with fresher flavours with the Cabernet expression particularly marked. Firm, dry finish. 48% Cabernet Sauvignon, 45% Merlot, 3% Cabernet Franc, 4% Petit Verdot. ABV 14.5%	Bottle	£80.00
Bordeaux France	Chateau Lagrange, Pomerol, J P Moueix, 2019 Firm, slightly subdued tannins that build fairly quickly over the palate. There is an austerity and a clear liquorice wash over the cassis and blackberry fruits that should soften and fill out over ageing. 100% Merlot. ABV 14.5%	Bottle	£85.00
Bordeaux France	Les Griffons De Pichon Baron 2nd Wine of Ch. Pichon-Longueville, Pauillac, 2018 The nose is delicate, with notes of black fruits and a hint of subtle, well-integrated wood. The palate is generous and full, with powerful and luscious tannins. The balance is rich and harmonious with tension. The finish is racy and refreshingly long. A wine which reflects the terroir and expresses the year's full potential. 52% Cabernet Sauvignon / 48% Merlot. ABV 14.5%	Bottle	£90.00
Bordeaux France	Segla 2nd Wine of Ch. Rauzan-Segla, Margaux, 2016 Second wine of 2 ^{ème} Grand Cru Classé Château Rauzan-Ségla made for earlier drinking. Elegant, refined texture with depth, length and breadth of flavour. The nose is ripe and fragrant, with notes of blackcurrant, damson, violet and toasted oak. The tannins are soft and silky, with a persistent finish. 45% Cabernet Sauvignon / 53% Merlot / 1% Petit Verdot / 1% Cabernet Franc. ABV 13.5%	Bottle	£95.00
Bordeaux France	Les Fiefs De Lagrange 2nd Wine of Ch. Lagrange, Saint-Julien, 2010 Plummy ripe red and black fruits and a touch of cedar oak. Full bodied and well-structured with round tannin. This has good, firm, clean fruit with lovely overtones of mint. Good fruit character and a touch of caramel, with slightly earthy claret depth. 61% Cabernet Sauvignon / 30% Merlot / 9% Petit Verdot. Bordeaux France	Pagodes De Cos Rouge 2nd Wine of Ch. Cos D'Estournel, Saint-Estephe, 2014 The palate is medium-bodied with a silky-smooth entry, well-judged acidity with veins of tobacco and allspice emerging toward the finish that gently fans out. A pleasant freshness. Very fine. 55% Cabernet Sauvignon / 43% Merlot / 2% Petit Verdot.	Bottle	£125.00

Stellenbosch South Africa	Boekenhoutskloof, The Chocolate Block, 2022 After being purchased by investors in 1993, a novice 26 year old winemaker was brought in whose "beginner's luck" was swiftly shown to be real skill with each vintage becoming a benchmark for South African wines. Bay leaves, currants and violets on the nose with a touch of iron. It's medium to full-bodied, balanced and supple with herb and peppercorn freshness. 77% Syrah/9% Grenache/9% Cinsault/5% Cabernet Sauvignon. ABV 14.5%	Bottle	£80.00
