It has aromas of fresh fruit and dried fruit. Rich and aromatic on the palate, with a great structure offering a mineral finish. One of the Cider Maker and my favourites with oysters or shell fish! Ample and complete, this wine offers flavours of white fruits and honey. The village of Lugny is located high up in the South of the Macon region. It has a great reputation for its white wines which has made Macon famous. It is well known that the village of Lugny, with its limestone soils and warm climate, produces the most coveted white wines of the region. The vineyard of 'Les Genievres' is one of the best. Sauternes, France	Château Guiraud Sauternes 1er Grand Cru Classé, 2006 One of the finest Sauternes – the palate is viscous and very well-balanced with acidity cutting through intense mango, marmalade and apricot flavours. Veneto Italy	Pinot Grigio Rosé, Ponte It has a light pink nuance with copper reflections. Fruity, delicate, complex on the nose. Light with intense aromas of rose and red apple. It is an ideal aperitif but also matches well with slightly spicy foods. ABV 12%	75cl Bottle 175cl Glass	£18.50 £6.50
Provence, France	Château Pas de Cerf "Diane" Rosé, 2022 Named after one of the 3 winemaker sisters at Chateau Pas du Cerf, Diane is a lovely, light Provence rosé made from a blend of Cinsault (30%), a local grape called Tibouren (30%), Grenache (30%) and Mourvedre (10%). Provence, France	Château de la Gaudie “Garance” 2022 From typical Provence red grapes (60% Grenache, 10% Cinsault & 30% Syrah) comes this wonderful, elegant rosé. A discreet nose of small red fruits such as strawberries & raspberries is followed through on the palate giving a soft, smooth finish. Perfect aperitif and accompaniment to Mediterranean dishes. Provence, France	Château Léoube Rosé, 2022 (Organic) Winemaker Romain Ott produces this Provence rosé typical of the region (dry, light fruitiness, aromatic) from a blend of red grapes (Grenache, Cinsault, Mourvèdre, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah) resulting in a well balanced refreshing wine. Great with fish, shellfish, salads, lightly spiced foods and Mediterranean style dishes. ABV 13.5%	75cl Bottle	£44.00
Provence, France	Whispering Angel, Cave d’Esclans Made from Grenache, Cinsault and Rolle (Vermentino), its pale colour is pleasing to the eye and draws one in. The rewarding taste profile is full and lush while being bone dry with a smooth finish. Highly approachable and enjoyable. Created by Sacha Lichine following his acquisition of Château d’Esclans in 2006, his vision was to create the greatest rosés in the world igniting the “Rosé Renaissance”. Rhone, France	Cotes du Rhone, “La Chapelle de Marin” With attractive, juicy, bramble fruit and floral aromas, the palate is up-front and fresh with warm spice and real depth. This is a classic southern Rhone red; ripe and characterful with smooth supple tannins. Lovely with grilled meats and Mediterranean style food. This is the Cider Maker’s “go to, quaffing wine”! France	Pinot Noir “Domaine de Valmoissine”, Louis La Tour A fruity wine which offers a soft and silky palate with soft tannins. Domaine de Valmoissine is located on the site of the ancient monastery of Valmoissine at 500 meters above sea-level. This guarantees sunshine during the summer months whilst remaining cool at night and limits the possibility of spring frosts. The vineyard's southern exposure gives the grapes perfect maturity at the same time as the Grands Crus of Corton. The yield is small in order to ensure perfect maturity and concentration of the grapes, the factors that create the best quality wines. This results in an elegant wine with remarkable finesse. 	French Red Wines:		
Lussac, Bordeaux France	Château Lucas St Emilion, 2016 Château Lucas of Lussac-Saint-Émilion comprises equal parts Merlot and Cabernet Franc. 20% of this wine is aged for 12-18 months in oak barrels before blending with wine aged in stainless steel and concrete vats. Deep ruby red in hue the nose is perfumed with those similar dark fruit characteristics on the nose. A balance of earthy spices, tobacco and blackcurrants in the mouth. Lussac is an up and coming satellite appellation of the renowned Saint Emilion region on the the Right Bank of Bordeaux. There is no doubt that one of Lussac's most prized properties is Château Lucas, owned by the Vauthier family of Château Ausone fame. From just 18 hectares of vines, three cuvée are produced. The top wine, aptly called Château Lucas, is produced from a 12-hectare vineyard, comprising equal parts Merlot and Cabernet Franc. While so much of the Right Bank focuses on Merlot, the high percentage of Cabernet Franc brings a polished lift to the cuvée, vintage in and vintage out. Pairs well with red meat. Rhone, France	Dom. de la Janasse Cotes du Rhone "Terre d'Argile", 2022 Fine, rich, Cotes du Rhone Villages, the Terre d'Argile is literally a stone's throw from their Châteauneuf-du-Pape vineyards; 25% Grenache, 25% Syrah, 25% Mourvèdre & 25% Carignan, complex flavour of blackcurrant and tapenade, a full-bodied style resembling it's high profile neighbour. Pairs well with lamb chops. ABV 14.5%	75cl Bottle	£40.00
Bordeaux France	Château Fonbel, St Emilion Grand Cru, 2019 Located in the South of Saint Emilion, Chateau Fonbel is owned by the Vauthier family of Ausone and yet this is great value Grand Cru St Emilion. The 2019 vintage is a Merlot-dominant blend complemented by some Cabernet Sauvignon and, since 2004, Carmenère. Aromas of blueberries & raspberries with a certain 'earthiness'. Medium to full-bodied, succulent with delicate tannins. To keep the fruit in the foreground only 30% of the wine is aged in barrel, with 70% in stainless steel. ABV 14%	75cl Bottle	£58.50
Burgundy, France	Domaine Tollot-Beaut Chorey-Les-Beaune "Piece du Chapitre" Monopole, 2021 A light and supple Pinot Noir from arguably the best producer in the smallest appellation in Beaune – Chorey-Les-Beaune. Full of character, the nose is dominated by small dark fruits (blackberry, blueberry, cherry) with light notes of liquorice. It is well-built with elegant tannins and a well-rounded structure that gives a nice long palate. ABV 13%	75cl Bottle	£68.00

Rioja, Spain	Paco Garcia Crianza, 2019 Relatively new winery (2001) in Rioja introducing a new younger style of wine. This 2019 crianza is made from 90% Tempranillo and 10% Garnacha, 12 months in oak, nicely balanced for a good vintage. NB. The hand is that of founder Paco Garcia, the winemaker's father. Rioja, Spain	Urbina Selección 2000 Made from a selection of the very best Tempranillo grapes of the family-run Urbina Single Estate from vines more than 20 years old, it has had 28 days maceration followed by 15 months ageing in new American oak barrels. Intense, dark ruby, very concentrated berry/vanilla nose and flavours, full-bodied, well-structured with the fine elegance of the Urbina marque. ABV 13.5%	75cl Bottle	£34.50
Ribera del Duero Spain	Bodegas Valduero Una Cepa, 2018 Ripe fruit on the nose, cherries, wild berries, roast aromas, vanilla & leather. A modern style of Ribero - elegant, smooth, already accessible, delicious! ABV 14%	75cl Bottle	£62.50
Piedmont, Italy	Barbera D’Asti, Luca Bosio (2022) Good, honest, value for money wine is the trademark of Luca Bosio Family Estates. Piedmont, Italy	Angelo Veglio Barolo A small grower, the vineyards of his eponymous winery are planted over the south-east slopes of La Morra in Piedmont. a location that is quickly gaining a reputation for producing some of the best wines in the region; attractive, with a fruity core. The Angelo Veglio Barolo bears all the hallmark flavours of the style: complex earthy and violet notes, with floral and spiced undertones. Yet, it is remarkable for a distinct lightness and fruitiness, typical of wines grown around La Morra, that really set it apart from the crowd. ABV 14.5%	75cl Bottle	£46.00
Toscana, Italy	Riecine Chianti Classico 2021 Award winning Chianti Classico from Gaiole in Tuscany. This mid-weight, classy, precise Chianti is really ‘moreish’. The Walker Bay Pinot Noir is an estate wine made from younger vines and vineyards on the lower slopes. Youthful perfume, floral notes along with dark berries and gentle spice and an earthy backbone. Mendoza, Argentina	Kaiken, Ultra Malbec This wine is deep ruby red in colour, with purple tones and a wonderful display of rich aromas. The nose is enticing and spicy with black fruit and floral notes. Structured with soft tannins that lead to a finish that is fresh, complex and long, with fruit notes and subtle undertones of rosemary, thyme and dried flowers. ABV 14.5%	75cl Bottle	£37.50
Margaret River, Australia	McHenry Hohnen Rocky Road, Shiraz, 2018 Margaret River, Australia = classy wines. Soft and juicy palate with ripe blueberries, plums and red berries.
